Project Lifesaver of Orange County NY

**An Extra Layer of Security for Those With Autism,
Alzheimer's & Related Disorders That Wander**

How it works

People enrolled will wear a transmitter device that emits a unique, identifiable radio frequency tracking signal. If the enrolled person goes missing, the caregiver is to call 911. The 911 call center will identify the person as enrolled in Project Lifesaver of Orange County NY and trained officers from the Sheriff's Office will be dispatched with locator equipment along with other first responders.

Terms and Conditions for Participation

- school aged child or adult ; and
- diagnosis of Autism, Alzheimer's or other related disorders; and
- at risk or history of wandering, eloping or becoming disoriented; and
- has in place 24/7 supervision (e.g., parent, family, school, day service); and
- will tolerate wearing the band/bracelet on the wrist or ankle; and
- resides in Orange County, N.Y. with primary caregiver; and
- caregiver(s) commits to daily battery checks, logging those checks and battery changes every 60 days to ensure proper functioning; and
- caregiver (s) commits to annual update, new digital picture, purchase new set of batteries

Cost (resources may be available for those in need of financial assistance)

Initial Kit \$300.00 (one-time fee)

Additional Bands/Straps vinyl or nylon \$1.75

Nylon bands require a snap lock@ \$.25 each

Annually, six batteries will be needed plus additional bands-less than \$10.00
